Meeting the French is a program established Paris that offers tourists to discover the French capital through contact to local people. Tourists can choose an accommodation (bed & breakfast, apartments) that is provided by a Parisian. The activities focus mainly on culture and gastronomy of France and are offered for groups as well as for individuals. Tourists can choose from a variety of

activities including cooking classes, dinners with Parisian hosts, gourmet tours and workshops. These workshops contain e.g. wine and cheese tasting as well as creative workshops. Furthermore, local people offer guided tours through the respective districts so tourists can have a different view of the French capital far from general tourist itineraries.

All the activities aim to give the tourist an insight into an intimate and authentic Paris and to learn about the lifestyle of the Parisians and the French culture.
